

Oil Painting Requirements: Unit II

PURPOSE:

1. To learn how to mix oil colors, texture and application of oils.
2. To learn how to use a palette knife, thinner and medium.
3. To learn how strokes and texture can be created with different ways of application (brushes, palette knives, sponges, etc.)
4. To learn how to use and care for the different brushes.
5. To learn transparent and opaque colors.
6. To learn how to pull a painting together and paint a picture to be proud of.
7. To learn how to properly frame your painting.

REQUIREMENTS UNIT II: (Include information learned in your story in the ZSuite 4-H Record Book.)

1. Correctly sketch the picture you desire to paint and exhibit it at the fair.
2. Study colors. Learn what happens when different colors are mixed.
3. Take a field trip and study nature.
4. Visit an art museum or study about art and oil paintings.
5. Learn about transparent and opaque colors, also medium and whites.
6. Learn what different brushes can do and how to care for them.
7. Learn about palette knives and painting surfaces, (canvasses.).
8. Paint at least two oil paintings no larger than 18"x24".
9. Learn how to frame and preserve your paintings.
