SRAPIE TAGS

REMEMBER: Scrapie tags are required for sheep and goat projects being sold through the Latah Market Animal Sale. These tags are important for disease traceability purposes.

Animal Biosecurity

Biosecurity is very important to keep you and your animal safe and healthy as fair draws near. Here are a few tips to remember:

- Clean and disinfect your equipment between animals
- Change or clean your boots before visiting other farms
- Wash your hands after handling animals




