

Guidelines
Family & Consumer Sciences:
Foods Achievement Award

1. 4-H'ers must be currently enrolled in their 5th year (or more) of a 4-H foods project.
2. 4-H'ers must at least be entering their sophomore year of High School.
3. 4-H'er must not have won this award previously.
4. 4-H'er must have completed entry form submitted to Nez Perce County Extension Office by October 1.
5. 4-H foods project must have received a blue ribbon during the year of application.
6. Individuals selecting the winner will not have judged the foods projects in the year of application.
7. Winner will receive a KitchenAid® standing mixer.
8. If less than 3 applications are received, there may be no award presented for that given year.
